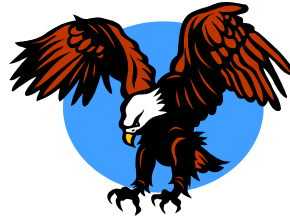

#### **Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Application Goals**

##### **Title I**

Center Drive School has 4 paid Ed\_Techs that provide **support in reading and math for low achieving students**. Most of the funding is provided by ESEA under Title I. Funding for **Summer School** is also provided by ESEA Title I. Some money for **HOMELESS students** is required to be put aside each year just in case we have students that qualify.

##### **Title II**

Title II Provides funding for teachers and support staff for **Professional Development Opportunities** which includes paying for approved **courses, workshops, and trainings**. We plan on providing multiple trainings after school for teachers on the new Envision Math curriculum.

##### **Title V**

Title V is a catch all for any project that can be shown to be educationally validated. We will purchase **electronics** such as, ipads, computers, Smart projectors, TVs and printers. We will also purchase **software licenses** for IXL, BrainPop, SuperTeacherWorksheets, and BrainPop Jr. We also register and pay a fee to **PREP** which allows all CDS staff to attend numerous Professional Development opportunities for no additional charge. Title V also pays for **substitutes** when teachers attend workshops. We also **purchase supplies** for Title I students and teachers. This year we hope for funding to pay for NWEA testing.

Of course, all projects need to be accepted by ESEA officials.
