Teachers and Ed Techs will be testing K-1 students in reading during the first weeks of school. The purpose of the testing is to identify problem areas. Low achieving students in Kindergarten will be included in the **Concepts About Print** program. Low achieving first graders may work with Mrs. Sharon Pelkey, Reading Specialist or work with a Title One Ed Tech to receive additional support. NWEA testing for grades 2-8 will begin the week of September 12. Grade 2, 3 & 4 NWEA test data will be used to determine students Title One eligibility in reading and math.
